## H-F FPAC Covid-19 Safeguards

#### All students:

- Must be vaccinated against COVID-19 by December 31 in order to travel.
- Provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of departure.
- All students should be prepared to wear a mask or face covering as required in any public spaces.
- Must carry proof of COVID-19 vaccination at all times.

If a student becomes sick and tests positive for COVID-19 while on tour (a "breakthrough" infection), a parent/guardian will be required to escort their child home within 48 hours. A chaperone will be made available to stay on-site with a student during this time period.
