

## **Dress Code for Tour**

Attitude, behavior and academic achievement of the members of the H-F Band are influenced by dress and grooming. Please understand that we are representing our school and our country. It is important to dress professionally and to understand that Europeans may dress a bit more conservatively compared to what you may be used to.

Dress code for tour will follow the guidelines set forth in the parent/student handbook and are as follows:

### **Guidelines for student dress are:**

1. Hats, do-rags, bandanas, hoodies covering the head, and/or other headwear are not to be worn in the building or in outdoor classrooms during the school day.
2. Beachwear, pajamas, sleepwear, and underwear worn as outerwear are inappropriate.
3. Reasonable cleanliness and repair of apparel is expected.
4. Gym attire is to be confined to physical education activities unless directed by the deans.
5. Extremes of brevity in attire are inappropriate.  
Pants with holes located in areas which could cause them to be inappropriate.  
Strapless, backless, strap back, spaghetti strap, and halter tops/dresses are NOT allowed.
6. School activity uniforms that do not meet the dress code criteria may not be worn during the school day.

### **Shirt Requirements**

1. Shirt must be long enough to overlap the waistband of pants, skirts or shorts. (No crop tops)
2. Shoulderless, fitted tanks, and jersey-style tops must be worn with appropriate clothing underneath.
3. Neckline must be located at an appropriate level.
4. If a sheer, see-through or fishnet garment is worn, a shirt that meets the above criteria must be worn underneath.
5. Shirts may not promote/display drugs, alcohol, weapons, gambling, and/or inappropriate language.
6. Undergarments must be covered at all times.

### **Pants/Skirts/Dresses/Slit Requirements**

1. The waistband of all garments must be worn above the mid-portion of the hip.
2. Dresses/skirts/shorts/slits must be worn no higher than four inches above the knee.
3. No holes or ripped pants.
4. If leggings are worn, a shirt must be worn at mid-thigh or longer.

If a student is wearing clothes that do not meet the HF dress code they will be sent back to their room to change before leaving for the day.
