ITINERARY

Day 1 Wednesday, March 18, 2020 Depart from Chicago Depart from Chicago O'Hare to Frankfurt on Lufthansa Airlines. Your overnight transatlantic flight is about 8-hours. In-flight

Day 2 Thursday, March 19, 2020 Arrival | Krakow Afternoon arrival in Krakow. Check into the hotel and get settled into rooms. Walk to the main square and see the Hanseatic Cloth Hall. Dinner in a local restaurant. In-flight/D

Day 3 Friday, March 20, 2020

Krakow

Guided sightseeing of Krakow today, for centuries the residence of Polish kings. See the Market Square, the 14th century Jagiellonian University, St. Mary's Church and the Wawel Royal Castle. Afternoon exploring and shopping in the Old Town. Perform the first concert of the tour in Krakow. B/D

Day 4 Saturday, March 21, 2020 Auschwitz | Krakow

Travel outside of Krakow this morning to the infamous Auschwitz-Birkenau Nazi Concentration Camps, a sobering reminder of "Man's inhumanity to man" during the Holocaust of the last century. Continue to the Wieliczka Salt Mine, an amazing UNESCO World Heritage site. Tour the mine before returning to Krakow. Enjoy dinner in the Jewish Quarter this evening with live Klezmer music.

Day 5 Sunday, March 22, 2020 Krakow | Brno | Prague Early departure to Prague, capital city of the Czech Republic. Stop near Brno to see the Punkva Caves, a natural wonder in the Moravian Karst. Get lunch and then continue to Prague. On arrival check into the hotel. Enjoy an evening dinner cruise on the Vltava (Moldau) River.

Day 6 Monday, March 23, 2020

Prague

Begin sightseeing of the Old Town with a locally guided walking tour. See the Jan Hus Square, Tyne Church, Astronomical Clock, Estates Theatre and the Charles Bridge. Get lunch and explore the Old Town. Enjoy dinner and perform an evening concert at the Czech Museum of Music in Prague.

Prague

Sightseeing of Prague continues with a trip to the Prague Castle situated high above the city. See the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral and the nearby Golden Lanes. Cross the Charles Bridge and spend the afternoon in the Old Town. Evening free to get dinner and enjoy the Old Town in small groups.

Day 8 Wednesday, March 25, 2020 Český Krumlov | Salzburg Depart from the Prague to the charming Czech Bohemian village of Český Krumlov. Explore the town and get lunch before continuing to Salzburg. On arrival, check into the hotel and enjoy dinner at the Stieglkeller Restaurant.

Day 9 Thursday, March 26, 2020

Enjoy a guided walking tour of Salzburg that begins at the Mirabell Palace and Gardens. Cross the Salzach River into the Old Town where you see Mozart's birth-house, the Salzburg

Dom, and Hohensalzburg Fortress. Get lunch in the Old Town and do some souvenir shopping. Evening dinner and concert at a local community center.

The final two payments will be adjusted based on the results of fundraising efforts. Individual fundraising profits will be subtracted form the January payment. The earned share of "the Pot" will be subtracted from the February payment. In the event of tour cancellation by an individual, any individual fundraising profits will be paid to the Pot after fees charged by GrandTours.

The Pot – Because all students will benefit from these funds, it is expected that all students will help with group projects, including the auction in January of 2020. All students who have worked the minimum hours towards HF Band Parents sponsored fundraising projects will qualify for a share of the Pot. The funds in the Pot will be divided equally among the qualifying students after group expenses have been deducted.
